- ♣ God desires His people to have "Understanding" (head knowledge) AND a "Experience" (heart relationship) –John 4:23
- \$\frac{1}{2}\$ Shaking caused by the "Counsel to Laodicea" -Early Writings, p. 270
- ♣ "Shaking" described
- ₱ Jesus is eager to be involved in a meaningful friendship with us Revelation 3:20
- Things that can get in the way of a relationship with Jesus
- **♣** Jesus brings all that is needed with Him
